



**Napolitan News Service Survey**  
of 1,000 Registered Voters  
Conducted November 11-12, 2024

*1\* Over the summer, President Biden decided to step down and Kamala Harris became the Democratic nominee. Would the Democrats have done better in the recent election if President Biden had been the Democratic candidate?*

20% Yes  
57% No  
23% Not sure

*2\* President Biden chose to run last year despite concerns about his health. Would the Democrats have done better if President Biden had stepped down last year and allowed a primary to choose the Democratic candidate?*

54% Yes  
27% No  
19% Not sure

### **Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on November 11-12, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
