of 1,000 Registered Voters  
Conducted March 21-22, 2023

*1\* If a senior policy official fails to implement the president's policy because of his own deeply held beliefs, should the president be able to fire or otherwise discipline that policy official?*

54% Yes  
27% No  
18% Not sure

*2\* Should there be special protections in place to prevent the president from firing senior policy officials who disagree with that president's policy positions?*

55% Yes  
25% No  
20% Not sure

**Methodology**

This Counterpolling™ survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on March 21-22, 2023. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
