of 1,000 Registered Voters
Conducted November 18-19, 2024

1 The Constitution requires Cabinet members to be approved by the U.S. Senate. To move more quickly, President Trump asked the Senate to let him make “recess appointments.” This would allow Trump to appoint Cabinet members without Senate approval. Should the Senate follow normal procedure and confirm Cabinet members or should the new president be allowed to make recess appointments?*

- 68% The Senate should follow normal procedure and confirm Cabinet members
- 24% The new president should be allowed to make recess appointments
- 9% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on November 18-19, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation’s population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
