1 Should the federal government encourage people to buy electric vehicles rather than gas powered vehicles by using regulations and financial incentives? Or, should the government simply let consumers decide what cars best meet their needs?*

- 26% The government should encourage people to buy electric vehicles
- 67% The government should let consumers decide
- 7% Not sure

2 Currently, when someone buys an Electric Vehicle, \$7,500 of the purchase price is paid for by the government. When someone buys a gas powered vehicle, they do not receive any subsidy from the government. A proposal has been made to end the subsidy so that those who buy electric vehicles pay the full cost. Would you favor or oppose this proposal?*

- 36% Strongly favor
- 25% Somewhat favor
- 14% Somewhat oppose
- 12% Strongly oppose
- 14% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on November 18-19, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
