of 1,000 Registered Voters Conducted January 13-14, 2025

1* Would you favor or oppose making Greenland a part of the United States?

- 14% Strongly favor
- 23% Somewhat favor
- 14% Somewhat oppose
- 27% Strongly oppose
- 21% Not sure

2* Would you favor or oppose sending U.S. troops to take Greenland by force?

- 8% Strongly favor
- 8% Somewhat favor
- 16% Somewhat oppose
- 60% Strongly oppose
- 8% Not sure

3* Greenland is currently owned by Denmark. Some in Greenland would like it to be an independent nation rather than part of either Denmark or the United States. Should the United States support Greenland in its bid for independence? Or should it seek to make Greenland a part of the United States?

- 48% The U.S. should support Greenland in its bid for independence
- 16% The U.S. should seek to make Greenland a part of the United States
- 24% Neither
- 13% Not sure

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4* If most people living in Greenland wanted to become part of the United States, would you favor or oppose letting Greenland become part of the U.S.?

- 26% Strongly favor
- 35% Somewhat favor
- 13% Somewhat oppose
- 11% Strongly oppose
- 15% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on January 13-14, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
