49% Yes

89% Yes  
6% No  
5% Not sure

*3\* Suppose that, after finishing high school, a student does not possess the basic skills needed to get a good job and function as an adult in society. Should that person be allowed to graduate?*

22% Yes  
63% No  
15% Not sure

*4\* Last week, President Trump issued an executive order to eliminate the federal Department of Education. Do you favor or oppose eliminating the Department of Education?*

**Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on March 10, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
