1* How closely have you followed recent news stories about the attacks on Tesla dealerships and cars?

- 24% Very closely
- 42% Somewhat closely
- 23% Not very closely
- 11% Not at all closely
- 1% Not sure

2* Is it more likely that the attacks on Tesla are just actions by angry individuals or is there a coordinated effort to harm the company and its customers?

- 46% Angry Individuals
- 44% Coordinated effort
- 10% Not sure

3* Is it fair to call the attacks on Tesla and Tesla vehicles a form of domestic terrorism?

- 46% Yes
- 39% No
- 15% Not sure

4* When it comes time to buy your next car, how likely is it that you would consider buying a Tesla?

- 7% Very likely
- 14% Somewhat likely
- 20% Not very likely

5* While it's always difficult to see violence and property attacks, are the attacks on Tesla and Tesla vehicles justified?

19% Yes
70% No
11% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on March 26-27, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
