1 Should universities with billion dollar endowments be allowed to rely on the federal government's student loan program to help students pay for tuition, or should they be required to fund any student loans out of their own endowment funds?*

- 36% They should be allowed to rely on the federal student loan program
- 48% They should be required to fund student loans out of their own endowment funds
- 17% Not sure

2 If a university has an endowment fund worth more than a billion dollars, should it be eligible to receive research grants and other funding from the United States government?*

- 41% Yes
- 39% No
- 20% Not sure

3 Hundreds of universities, including Harvard, have endowment funds with more than \$1 billion in assets. Should the income earned by these endowment funds be taxed?*

- 45% Yes
- 34% No
- 21% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on April 21-22, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
