1\* How do you rate the way that the U.S. and state governments handled the COVID-19 pandemic?

- 8% Excellent
- 25% Good
- 26% Fair
- 36% Poor
- 4% Not sure

2\* Looking back, did the federal government overreact to the coronavirus pandemic in ways that did more harm than good?

42% Yes47% No10% Not sure

3\* At this point in time, is getting COVID pretty much the same as getting the flu or a bad cold?

64% Yes25% No11% Not sure

4\* Is the worst of the pandemic behind us, or is it still to come?

- 56% Behind us
- 29% Still to come
- 16% Not sure

## Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on April 30-May 1, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
