of 1,000 Registered Voters  
Conducted May 7-8, 2025

*1\* Which is more likely to cause illegal immigrants to leave the United States: requiring all employers to verify that their workers are legal residents of the United States, or free flights and \$1,000?*

70%	Requiring all employers to verify that their workers are legal residents
15%	Free flights and \$1,000
15%	Not sure

*2\* This week, the Trump Administration announced that they will pay for plane tickets for illegal immigrants to return to their home countries and will give them \$1,000 after they arrive back in those home countries. Do you favor or oppose this policy?*

17%	Strongly favor

**Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on May 7-8, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
