52% Yes  
29% No  
19% Not sure

*2\* If any of the arrested students were not U.S. citizens, should those students be deported?*

45% Yes  
37% No  
19% Not sure

*3\* Do you approve or disapprove of the recent protests on college campuses supporting the Palestinians?*

13% Strongly approve  
18% Somewhat approve  
20% Somewhat disapprove  
27% Strongly disapprove  
22% Not sure

**Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on May 12-13, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
