1* Do you have a favorable or an unfavorable opinion of the federal government's food stamps program?

- 28% Very favorable
- 39% Somewhat favorable
- 17% Somewhat unfavorable
- 8% Very unfavorable
- 9% Not sure

2* Suppose a family of four earns \$60,000 a year. Should they be eligible to receive food stamps?

46% Yes39% No15% Not sure

*3a** [Among all voters] Suppose a family of four earns \$30,000 a year. Should they be eligible to receive food stamps?

- 46% Not asked, say a family making \$60,000 should be eligible
- 37% Yes
- 8% No
- 9% Not sure

3b* [Among those who say a family making \$60,000 should not be eligible or are not sure] Suppose a family of four earns \$30,000 a year. Should they be eligible to receive food stamps?

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on May 14-15, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
