of 1,000 Registered Voters Conducted June 18-19, 2025

1* How closely have you been following the recent conflict between Israel and Iran?

- 24% Very closely
- 47% Somewhat closely
- 19% Not very closely
- 9% Not at all closely
- 1% Not sure

2* In the current conflict between Israel and Iran, which side should the United States support?

- 47% Israel
- 7% Iran
- 36% Neither
- 10% Not sure

3* Do you approve or disapprove of Israel's attack on Iran?

- 25% Strongly approve
- 17% Somewhat approve
- 19% Somewhat disapprove
- 25% Strongly disapprove
- 14% Not sure



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4* If Iran were to create a nuclear weapon, how serious a threat would that pose to Israel?

- 68% Very serious
- 21% Somewhat serious
- 5% Not very serious
- 2% Not at all serious
- 4% Not sure

5* If Iran had a nuclear weapon, how serious a threat would that pose to the United States?

- 53% Very serious
- 31% Somewhat serious
- 10% Not very serious
- 4% Not at all serious
- 2% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on June 18-19, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
