of 1,000 Registered Voters Conducted June 23-24, 2025

1* To reduce the backlog and decide on asylum requests in a more timely manner, a proposal has been made to hire more judges who can decide asylum cases. Would you favor or oppose increasing federal spending to hire more judges?

- 32% Strongly favor
- 33% Somewhat favor
- 14% Somewhat oppose
- 11% Strongly oppose
- 10% Not sure

2* If someone wishes to claim asylum in the United States, where should he or she wait while that claim is being processed?

- 24% In the bordering country from which he or she seeks to enter the U.S.
- 24% In his or her home country
- 27% In a supervised facility inside the United States
- 13% Anywhere he or she decides to travel inside the U.S.
- 12% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on June 23-24, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
