32%	Strongly favor
24%	Somewhat favor

2 A proposal has been made that would let employers sponsor any illegal immigrants working for them so that those workers could stay in the country. The employer would pay a \$1,000 sponsorship fee and be required to verify that all future employees are legal residents of the United States. Would you favor or oppose this proposal?*

40%	Somewhat favor

10%	Strongly oppose
12%	Not sure

3 Suppose an employer sponsors a number of illegal immigrants and agrees to verify that all future employees are legal residents of the United States. If that employer is caught hiring illegal immigrants again in the future, should the employer be arrested?*

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on June 23-24, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
