of 1,000 Registered Voters Conducted March 24-25, 2025

1* How closely have you followed recent news stories about Federal judges blocking President Trump's executive orders?

- 27% Very closely
- 44% Somewhat closely
- 21% Not very closely
- 6% Not at all closely
- 2% Not sure

2* Generally speaking, have judges gone too far in blocking the president's orders, not far enough, or is the balance about right?

- 27% Too far
- 37% Not far enough
- 25% About right
- 11% Not sure

3* Federal judges are generally assigned to a certain region or group of states. Should a judge assigned to a particular region be allowed to block the president's orders for the entire nation? Or, should the judges ruling apply only to their own region?

- 36% Block the president's orders for the entire nation
- 48% Apply only to their own region
- 17% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on March 24-25, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
