*1\* Does faster economic growth reduce the federal budget deficit?*

42%	Yes

*2\* Is cutting the number of federal government employees good for the economy or bad for the economy?*

21%	Very good for the economy
22%	Somewhat good for the economy
16%	Somewhat bad for the economy
22%	Very bad for the economy
11%	Neither good nor bad for the economy
9%	Not sure

*3\* Okay... is reducing the growth of federal government spending good for the economy or bad for the economy?*

24%	Very good for the economy
33%	Somewhat good for the economy

**Methodology**

Conducted by RMG Research, Inc. July 7-8, 2025  
Margin of Sampling Error: +/- 3.1 percentage points



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This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on July 7-8, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
