1 Which of the following is the better approach: allowing free speech even though it is sometimes offensive and inaccurate, or having the government determine what speech should be allowed?*

85%	Allowing free speech even though it is sometimes offensive and inaccurate
10%	Having the government determine what speech should be allowed
6%	Not sure

2 Which worries you more: disinformation and fake news or the federal government deciding what information and news should be allowed?*

32%	Disinformation and fake news
64%	Federal government deciding what information and news should be allowed
4%	Not sure

3 Does the federal government regularly promote disinformation and fake news to promote its own agenda?*

56%	Yes
17%	No
27%	Not sure



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Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on July 30-31, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
