



**Napolitan News Service Survey**  
of 1,000 Registered Voters  
Conducted August 4-5, 2025

*1\* When it comes to foreign policy, should NATO be given more responsibility and authority over operations involving U.S. troops, or should U.S. military operations be solely controlled by U.S. military officials?*

- 25% NATO should be given more responsibility and authority over operations involving U.S. troops
- 60% U.S. military operations should be solely controlled by U.S. military officials
- 15% Not sure

*2\* When it comes to public health and pandemic responses, should the World Health Organization be given more authority to set rules for the United States to follow? Or should those rules be set by U.S. officials?*

- 46% The World Health Organization should be given more authority to set rules for the United States to follow
- 43% Rules should be set by U.S. officials
- 11% Not sure

**Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on August 4-5, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
