2 Last week, the United States fired on a Venezuelan boat that was reportedly carrying drugs to the United States. Is it appropriate for the U.S. military to fire on and destroy drug smuggling boats, or should the boats be intercepted and the suspects arrested?*

44%	It is appropriate to fire on and destroy drug smuggling boats
52%	The boats should be intercepted and the suspects arrested
4%	Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 10-11, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
