Conducted September 16-17, 2025

1 Over the past week, several people have been fired from their jobs because of comments they made on social media about the assassination of Charlie Kirk. Is it appropriate for private companies to fire people who celebrate an assassination online?*

51%	Yes
35%	No
14%	Not sure

2 Should reporters or public officials be fired if they celebrate an assassination on social media?*

59%	Yes
28%	No
13%	Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 16-17, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
