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4 Is President Trump's executive order mostly a legitimate response to problematic behavior, or is it mostly political theater ahead of next year's elections?*

- 41% A legitimate response to problematic behavior
- 51% Political theater ahead of next year's elections
- 8% Not sure

5 Are recent efforts to send the National Guard into U.S. cities a legitimate response to high rates of crime in those cities, or are they mostly about shaming Democratic mayors and governors ahead of next year's elections?*

- 47% A legitimate response to high rates of crime
- 47% Shaming Democratic mayors and governors
- 6% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 16-17, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
