1 Is there a partial shutdown of the federal government at this time?*

16%	Yes
56%	No
28%	Not sure

2 In fact, there is no government shutdown at this time, but if congressional leaders are unable to reach an agreement by the end of September, a partial shutdown would begin on October 1. How serious a problem would it be if an agreement is not reached and the government is shutdown?*

43%	Very serious
42%	Somewhat serious
9%	Not very serious
3%	Not at all serious
2%	Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 23-24, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
