1* How serious a problem is domestic terrorism in the United States?

- 42% Very serious
- 41% Somewhat serious
- 11% Not very serious
- 3% Not at all serious
- 2% Not sure

2* Over the past few years, has domestic terrorism become a bigger problem, become a smaller problem, or stayed about the same?

- 30% Much bigger
- 43% Somewhat bigger
- 9% Somewhat smaller
- 3% Much smaller
- 13% Stayed about the same
- 2% Not sure

3* When it comes to domestic terrorism, is it mostly perpetrated by conservatives, liberals, or both about equally?

- 26% Conservatives
- 32% Liberals
- 32% Both about equally
- 10% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on October 8-9, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is \pm 3.1 percentage points.
