1 Some states issue driver's licenses to illegal immigrants. Do you favor or oppose issuing driver's licenses to illegal immigrants?*

15%	Strongly favor
19%	Somewhat favor
15%	Somewhat oppose
39%	Strongly oppose
12%	Not sure

2 Should someone who cannot speak English be allowed to get a driver's license?*

39%	Yes
47%	No
13%	Not sure

3 In some states, Commercial Driver's Licenses (CDLs) are being issued with "No Name Given." Should states be allowed to issue CDLs without documentation to prove a person's identity, including his or her full name?*

20%	Yes
69%	No
11%	Not sure



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Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on October 13-14, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
