of 1,000 Registered Voters Conducted November 5-6, 2025

1\* How closely have you been following news about the mayoral election in New York?

25% Very closely

39% Somewhat closely

19% Not very closely

17% Not at all closely

1% Not sure

2\* This week, Zohran Mamdani was elected mayor of New York. He calls himself a Democratic Socialist, and advocates policies like city run grocery stores, a \$30/hour minimum wage, and taxpayer funded centers to help people change gender. Will Zohran Mamdani be good for New York or bad for New York?

25% Very good for New York

20% Somewhat good for New York

13% Somewhat bad for New York

31% Very bad for New York

10% Not sure

3\* Some have suggested that Zohran Mamdani is the future of the Democratic party. Regardless of your own preferences, who would have a better chance in the next presidential election, a candidate like Mamdani or a more traditional Democrat?

27% A candidate like Mamdani

59% A more traditional Democrat

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## Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on November 5-6, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is  $\pm$  3.1 percentage points.
