of 1,000 Registered Voters  
Conducted November 19-20, 2025

*1\* A proposal has been made to provide universal child care for all Americans. The proposal would cost taxpayers approximately \$100 billion annually. Would you favor or oppose this proposal?*

22%	Strongly favor
32%	Somewhat favor
18%	Somewhat oppose
20%	Strongly oppose
8%	Not sure

*2\* If universal childcare funding was available, who should decide what type of child care is appropriate— the federal government, state and local governments, or parents?*

15%	The federal government
33%	State and local governments
42%	Parents
10%	Not sure

**Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on November 19-20, 2025. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
