1 How closely have you been following news about events in Iran?*

23%	Very closely
42%	Somewhat closely

2 Over recent weeks, large-scale anti-government protests have broken out across Iran. In the government crack-down, more than 2500 protesters have been killed. President Trump has announced a 25% tariff on countries that trade with Iran. Do you favor or oppose this policy?*

3 President Trump has also said that those killing the protesters “will pay a big price.” Would you favor or oppose additional sanctions and economic penalties against the Iranian government?*

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Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on January 14-15, 2026. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
