1 Generally speaking, do political reporters try to present fair and unbiased news coverage, or do they try to help the candidates they want to win?*

- 32% Try to present fair and unbiased news coverage
- 57% Try to help the candidates they want to win
- 11% Not sure

2 Suppose a reporter uncovered some information that was harmful to his or her preferred candidate. Would he or she report the information honestly or hide it to protect that preferred candidate?*

- 37% Report the information honestly
- 47% Hide it to protect that preferred candidate
- 16% Not sure

3 Which presidential candidate do most political journalists want to win?*

- 19% Donald Trump
- 56% Kamala Harris
- 9% Both equally
- 16% Not sure

Methodology

This Counterpolling™ survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on August 21-22, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
