17%	It should be available to anyone who is able to clearly articulate a desire to die.
32%	It should be available, but only to those with severe physical illnesses and less than 6 months to live.
25%	It should be available to those with severe physical and mental illnesses with no meaningful prospect of recovery.
22%	It should never be available in any circumstances.
4%	Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on April 1-2, 2026. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
