38%	Strongly favor
24%	Somewhat favor
13%	Somewhat oppose
9%	Strongly oppose
15%	Not sure

2 According to many studies, heart attacks, strokes, car crashes, and hospital admissions all increase when the clocks change. Knowing this to be true, do you favor or oppose making daylight savings time permanent?*

40%	Strongly favor
23%	Somewhat favor
15%	Somewhat oppose
8%	Strongly oppose
13%	Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on June 1-2, 2026. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
