- 9% Very likely
- 17% Somewhat likely
- 35% Not very likely
- 22% Not at all likely
- 17% Not sure

3 Which of the following is the leading cause of gun deaths in the United States?*

- 42% Mass shootings
- 24% Gang warfare
- 16% Suicide
- 8% Crimes of passion
- 5% Shootings by law enforcement
- 6% Other

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 16, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
