Conducted October 9-10, 2024

1 When deciding who should be allowed to legally enter the country and become permanent residents, should we give preference to people from cultures who share our basic values of human rights?*

57% Yes
25% No
18% Not sure

2 When it comes to allowing people to become permanent residents of the United States, are all cultures equally valid, or are some more compatible with American values than others?*

58% All are equally valid
33% Some are more compatible with American values
9% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on October 9-10, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
