1 Which of the following best describes your views on immigration?*

- 14% Both legal and illegal immigration are bad for the United States.
- 73% Legal immigration is good for the United States, but illegal immigration is bad.
- 9% Both legal and illegal immigration are good for the United States.
- 4% Not sure

2 How important is it for the United States to secure the southern border and end illegal immigration?*

- 65% Very important
- 24% Somewhat important
- 8% Not very important
- 2% Not at all important
- 1% Not sure

3 [Among all voters] Generally speaking, if someone enters the United States legally, how long should he or she have to live in this country before they can apply for citizenship and vote in U.S. elections?*

- 30% Not asked, answered no or not sure
- 14% 1 year or less
- 24% 2-3 years
- 18% 4-6 years
- 9% More than 6 years
- 4% Not sure

Methodology

Conducted by RMG Research, Inc. October 9-10, 2024
Margin of Sampling Error: +/- 3.1 percentage points

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on October 9-10, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
