of 1,000 Registered Voters  
Conducted October 14-15, 2024

*1\* Is it more important to make sure everyone can go to college or to create more good jobs for people who don't have college degrees?*

24%	Make sure everyone can go to college
70%	Create more good jobs for people who don't have college degrees
5%	Not sure

*2\* Is it more important for high schools to prepare students for jobs and careers or to prepare students for college?*

73%	Jobs and careers
16%	College
11%	Not sure

### **Methodology**

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on October 14-15, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
