Conducted September 23-25, 2024

1 Suppose you had a choice between four presidential candidates. All four had equal skills and temperament. Would you prefer a Republican who supported policies like President Trump's, a more traditional Republican, a Democrat who supported policies similar to Senator Bernie Sanders', or a more traditional Democrat?*

38%	A Republican supporting Trump's policies
13%	A more traditional Republican
20%	A Democrat supporting Sanders' policies
24%	A more traditional Democrat
5%	Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 2,952 Likely Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 23-25, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Likely Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 1.8 percentage points.
